

## All Saints Catholic High School

All Saints Catholic High School has an admission number of 200  
410 on time applications that named the school as a preference were received

Preference 1 = 267    Preference 2 = 108    Preference 3 = 34    Preference 4 = 1

The oversubscription criteria were applied to all applicants by the admission authority of the school and places were allocated as follows:

Children whose Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) names the school as provision are placed with priority, thus reducing the number of places available for allocation.

Oversubscription occurred within criterion 6. The distance tie-break was therefore applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived 0.822 miles from the school (as the crow flies).
