

September 2021 reception class intake allocation results

St Andrew the Apostle Catholic Voluntary Aided Primary School

The above named school was oversubscribed for entry to reception class in September 2021 (i.e. the school received more requests for places than the number of places available to offer).

A total of 70 on-time applications that named the school were received
Preference 1 = 41 Preference 2 = 13 Preference 16

As a voluntary aided school, the governing body of the school are responsible for setting and applying the oversubscription criteria (or the 'admission policy') in order to determine which children can be offered places and who can not.

The published admission number for this school is **30** – places were allocated as follows:

5. Non-Catholic children with a sibling in the school at the time of admission.	3
6. Children from other Christian denominations	-
7. Children of other faiths	-

The last child to secure a place fell within criterion 5.

The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived 0.456 miles from the school (as the crow flies).
