

September 2021 reception class intake allocation results

Stockbridge Village Community Primary School

The above-named school was oversubscribed for entry to reception class in September 2021 (i.e. the school received more requests for places than the number of places available to offer)

A total of 44 on-time applications that named the school were received
Preference 1 =33 Preference 2 = 6 Preference 3 =5

As a community school, the local authority is responsible for setting and applying the oversubscription criteria (or the 'admission policy') in order to determine which children can be offered places and who can not.

The published admission number for this school is 30 – places were allocated as follows:

Oversubscription Criteria (Admission Policy) ¹	Number of places allocated
Children whose Education, Health and Care Plan names the school as provision	-
1. Children currently/previously in the care of the local authority	-
2. Children with a sibling in the school	14
3. Distance from home to school measured in a straight line	16
Total	30

The last child to secure a place fell within criterion 3.

All children who applied under criterion 3 were admitted and the distance for the last child to secure a place lived 0.438 miles from the school (as the crow flies).

After considering all on-time applications this school was full to the admission number. Late applications could only be added to the waiting list.
