INTRODUCTION

Since 2010 Knowsley has embarked on an ambitious programme leveraging in millions of pounds of funding to improve and transform the borough's parks and green spaces and to maximise their community use.

Protecting and enhancing green spaces has formed a central part of the Council's place making approach to help make Knowsley an attractive place to live, work, and visit.

The Green Space Action Plan (2024 - 2030) builds upon the previous Green Space Strategy documents and provides a reference point for all matters relating to the Council's parks and green spaces, providing a framework for decision making that will ensure that these important public assets are managed in an accountable, sustained, and consistent manner.

The Green Space Action Plan priorities range in scale and complexity from master planning and cost feasibility work to support external grant applications to the delivery of large-scale capital programmes.

The priorities and indicative timescales have been set based on the following:

- To retain existing quality standards and/or to improve quality, accessibility or quality standards
- To ensure cyclical maintenance is identified and prioritised in a timely manner
- To develop and deliver transformative green improvement projects that meet the changing needs and aspirations of the communities they serve
- To respond to the availability of external funding opportunities
- To maximise the use of green spaces and support green space volunteers

The Green Space Action Plan cannot realistically be an all-encompassing document which expresses every detail or objective. It has been drafted at a point in time with indicative timescales for delivery. However, the Action Plan is intended to be a flexible document which can respond to changing internal and external factors and opportunities which may arise, including community consultation outcomes, legal or planning requirements and the availability of external grant funding.
