



Info Sheet 2 - February 2025 Issue - Construction Phase 1

Following on from the consultation last year work is about to commence on an Active Travel and Capacity Improvement Scheme on Moorgate Road and the East Lancashire Road (A580) providing a fit for purpose, high quality, resilient network for the future. Works will be undertaken in different phases with later works involving Junction 4 of the M57 motorway.

A580 onto Moorgate Road North



Dates - 28/02/2025 - 27/05/2025

The works involve modifications to the pedestrian island to accommodate an additional lane on Moorgate Road South. Improvements will also be made to the kerb line of the left-turn lane (northwest radius) to facilitate the positioning of a new segregated cycle lane across the western arm of Moorgate Road.

As part of this phase, footway works will also be carried out, extending from East Lancashire Road towards Ribblers Lane.

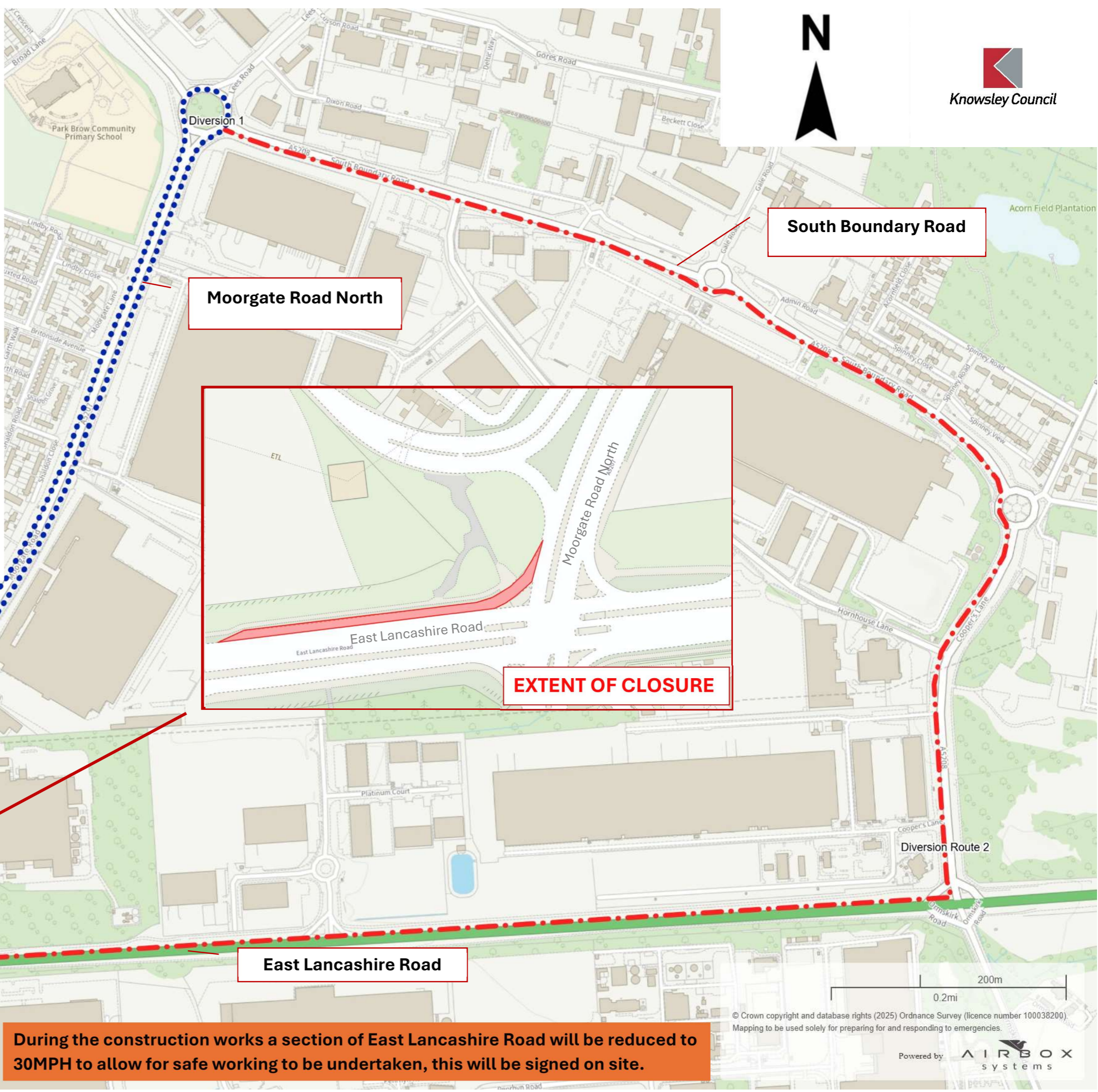

A580 ONTO MOORGATE NORTH - TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ARRANGEMENT

- The left turn going west on East Lancashire onto Moorgate Road North will be closed during this time and a diversion route will be in place. – Follow diversion route 2
- East Lancashire Road in an eastern direction (towards St Helens) will be reduced to one lane whilst construction of the pedestrian island is underway, this work is to facility the new lane on Moorgate Road South. Once the works on the island are complete the traffic management will be relaxed and two-lane running will resume.
- Moorgate Road South will be reduced to two lane running on the approach to the junction (one straight ahead lane and one right hand lane).
- Moorgate Road North, travelling north, will be reduced to one lane until motorists are safely past the works area this will then go back to two lanes.
- The left turn from Moorgate South onto East Lancashire Road Western arm towards Liverpool will be prohibited for the full duration of the works, this will be made permanent once the works have finished (Subject to approval of Traffic Regulation Order)



During the construction works a section of East Lancashire Road will be reduced to 30MPH to allow for safe working to be undertaken, this will be signed on site.
