

Kirkby High School (Academy)

2025 Published Admission Number (PAN) = **200**

During the allocation of places, the Academy Trust confirmed to the Local Authority, that they agreed to admit above the published PAN to a maximum of **208**.

A total of 361 applications naming the school as a preference were considered in the allocation of places

208 Places were allocated as detailed below:

Oversubscription occurred within criterion 4. The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived 3.030 miles from the school (as the crow flies).
